Our services

Adult Services

Our Practitioners cover the whole of Northumberland, offering practical and emotional support on a 1 to 1 basis in a safe space or your home address if it is safe to do so.

We also offer specialist courses such as The Freedom Programme, Freedom Forever and The Recovery Toolkit.

Young People

We provide Specialist services for young people who have been affected by domestic violence or abuse, in a family setting or in their own relationships even if they don't live with a partner.

We also offer counselling and therapeutic work to children of Service Users with one-to-one support.

Prevention Work

We deliver prevention work in schools and community groups to inform young people about abuse to educate them and stop them becoming victims or offenders themselves.

DVSA Car Scheme

One of our specialist Domestic Abuse Workers accompanies Northumbria Police on Friday and Saturday nights to attend domestic abuse incidents as they happen, allowing us to provide specialist support for victims at the time of crisis.
